This practice note is issued in terms of Regulation 4(2)(b) of the Companies Regulation, 2011 and is applicable to external companies.

The Companies and Intellectual Property Commission ("CIPC") in the interest of transparency of the origin or jurisdiction under which external companies are incorporated, will continue with the practice as established under the Companies Act, 61 of 1973 to subjoin to the name the statement "Incorporated in ...(stating the name of the jurisdiction)" in brackets.
