| 2. Transfer of the registration of an animal identification mark (Reg.6(2)) | R150 per application |
| 3. Copy of animal identification certificate | R150 per application |
| 4. Application for duties of pound master in terms of section 14 of the Act (Reg. 8(1)) | R150 per application |
| 5. Application for registration as marking operator (Reg. 7(2)) | R150 per application |
| 6. Registered post (optional) | Determined by service provider |
