Subject: Polymer Modified Bitumen Stabilising Material: Soil Stabiliser

Description: PMBSM soil stabiliser, is a poly modified bitumen emulsion. It is used for stabilising road

base construction materials for non-paved gravel roads.

PMBSM is constituted through a chemical reaction by combining polymers and bitumen emulsion. Depending on the moisture content of the soil, PMBSM can be diluted with water to obtain the required optimum moisture content. The resultant mixture is added to natural gravels to form a water resistant, elastic and robust layer. The addition of PMBSM produces a Bitumen Stabilising Material design that results in increased strength and durability of the base course while repelling the ingress of water.

The mix design and application rate depend on the site-specific material and the required road design specifications.

PMBSM is applied at ambient temperature by use of calibrated recyclers or Bitumen distributors. It is applied as a form of bitumen stabilizing material and the standard design methods detailed in SANRAL's manual South African Pavement Engineering Manual (SAPEM) 2013 and South African Bitumen Association (SABITA)`s TG2 are applicable. Alternatively New Age Road Solutions' guideline documents offer application methods.
