Explanatory Memorandum to the Provincial Allocations set out in the Schedule

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2018 (Act No. 1 of 2018), as amended, and provides information on adjustments to existing allocations to provinces in the 2018/19 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to stop the flow of funds in terms of Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2018, as amended, and the need to re-allocate the stopped funds to a province, as approved in terms of Section 20 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2018, as amended.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Amendment Act, 2018.

This notice affects the Early Childhood Development Grant

- a) In compliance with Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2018, as amended, the national Department of Social Development stops the transfer of funds to Northern Cape (R1.976 million), following revised allocations by the national Department of Social Development.
- b) In compliance with Section 20 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2018, as amended, the national Department of Social Development re-allocates funds to KwaZulu-Natal (R1.976 million), following revised allocations by the national Department of Social Development.
