

HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT, 1974 (ACT No.56 OF 1974)

REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION OF BASIC AMBULANCE ASSISTANTS, AMBULANCE EMERGENCY ASSISTANTS, OPERATIONAL EMERGENCY CARE ORDERLIES AND PARAMEDICS: AMENDMENT

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In these Regulations, "Regulations" means the Regulations Relating to the Qualifications for Registration of basic Ambulance Assistants, Ambulance Emergency Assistants, Operational Emergency Care Orderlies and Paramedics published in the Government Notice No. 49 Government Gazette No. 40577 of 27 January 2017.

Amendment of Regulation 2 of the Regulations

2. Regulation 2 of the regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for sub regulation (2) of the following sub regulation:-

"(2) The Registrar may register, as an Ambulance Emergency Assistant, any person who obtained, prior to the promulgation of these Regulations or by 31 December 2022 after the promulgation of these Regulations, any of the relevant Ambulance Emergency Assistant qualifications listed in the Annexure".

Short Title

3. These Regulations are called the Regulations Relating to the Qualifications for Registration of Basic Ambulance Assistants, Ambulance Emergency Assistants, Operational Emergency Care Orderlies and Paramedics, Amendment 2019.
