WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE TRANSFER OF CONTROL OF INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE LICENCE AND INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK SERVICE LICENCE BY CMC NETWORKS PROPRIETARY LIMITED ("CMC NETWORK") FROM CMC B-BBEE EMPLOYEE SHARE TRUST ("CMC SHARE TRUST") TO ASCENSION FUND NO 7 LLP ("ASCENSION FUND")

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it has received a letter from CMC Proprietary Limited ("CMC Network") for the withdrawal of its transfer of control applications for Individual Electronic Communications Service (I-ECS) and Individual Electronic Communications Network Service (I-ECNS) Licences from CMC B-BBEE Share Trust ("CMC Share Trust") to Ascension Fund No 7 LLP ("Ascension Fund").
- 2. The applications were lodged in terms of regulation 11 of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Individual Licences and Special Temporary Authorisations of 2010 read with sections 13(1) and (2) of the Electronic Communications Act, No. 36 of 2005.
- On 22 February 2021, the Authority published a notice in Government Gazette
 No. 44176 inviting written representations to the transfer of control applications.
 No written representations were received.
- 4. On 07 April 2021, the Authority received a letter from CMC Network requesting the Authority to withdraw the transfer of control applications.

5. Based on the withdrawal notice above, the notice of 22 February 2021 is similarly withdrawn.
