NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT: AIR QUALITY ACT, 2004 (ACT NO. 39 OF 2004)

REPEAL OF THE REGULATIONS REGARDING FUEL BURNING APPLIANCES IN DWELLING HOUSES MADE IN TERMS OF SECTION 44(1)(dA) OF THE ATMOSPHERIC POLLUTION PREVENTION ACT, 1965

I, Barbara Dallas Creecy, Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, hereby, in terms of section 53(p) of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act, 2004 (Act No. 39 of 2004) repeal the Regulations regarding Fuel Burning Appliances in Dwelling Houses, made in terms of section 44(1)(dA) of the Atmoshperic Pollution Prevention Act, 1965 (Act No. 45 of 1965), as contained in the Schedule hereto.

The reason for the repeal is that the Atmospheric Pollution Prevention Act, 1965 (Act No. 45 of 1965) has been repealed and the Regulations have become redundant.
