NOTICE ON THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF THE CROSS-BORDER ROAD TRANSPORT AGENCY (C-BRTA)

The Cross-Border Road Transport Agency is a national public entity established in terms of the Cross-Border Road Transport Act, 1998 (Act 4 of 1998).
