NOTICE OF INTENT TO CANCEL THE REGISTRATION OF PM ACADEMY (PTY) LTD AS A PRIVATE HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION

I, Phil Mjwara, Acting Director-General of the Department of Higher Education and Training, hereby, in terms of section 63(a) of the Higher Education Act, 1997 (Act No. 101 of 1997, as amended) (the Act) and Regulation 17(3) of the Regulations for the Registration of Private Higher Education Institutions, 2016 (the Regulations), give notice of intent to cancel the registration of PM Academy (Pty) Ltd as a private higher education institution. The reasons for my notice of intent to cancel the institution's registration is that PM Academy (Pty) Ltd has ceased to meet the eligibility criteria for providing higher education as required by section 1 of the Act and it ceases to meet the requirements for registration as required by sections 1 and 53(1)(b)(ii) of the Act and Regulations 21(a) and (d).

The notice of intent to cancel the registration of PM Academy (Pty) Ltd will take immediate effect. As of the date of this notice, PM Academy (Pty) Ltd must not enrol new students for higher education programmes. PM Academy must phase out pipe-line students by 31 December 2021.
