Amendment of Clause 9.9

A legal practitioner shall, in giving any advice about the prospects of success in any matter, give a true account of his or her opinion and shall not pander to a client's whims or desires. However, in any matter in which the legal practitioner's opinion is adverse to the prospects of success, the legal practitioner may upon client's insistence place before a court the client's case for the adjudicating officer to decide the matter and the legal practitioner shall advance that case as best as <u>circumstances</u> <u>allow</u>.
