## **MERCHANT SHIPPING ACT, 1951 (ACT NO. 57 OF 1951)**

## THE DRAFT MERCHANT SHIPPING (CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPMENT OF FISHING VESSELS OF LESS THAN 24 METRES IN LENGTH AND EQUAL TO OR MORE THAN 25 GT.) REGULATIONS, 2022
