Explanatory Memorandum to the Provincial Allocations set out in the Schedule

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2022 (Act No. 5 of 2022), as amended, and provides information on adjustments to existing allocations to provinces in the 2022/23 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to stop the flow of funds in terms of Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2022, as amended, and to re-allocate the stopped funds to provinces, as approved in terms of Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2022, as amended.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Act Amendment Act, 2022.

This notice affects the Human Settlements Development Grant (HSDG) and the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant: Provinces (ISUPG)

- a) In compliance with Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2022, as amended, the national department of Human Settlements stops the transfer of funds to Free State (R100 million) and Limpopo (R100 million) for the Human Settlements Development Grant, following revised allocations by the national Department of Human Settlements.
- b) In compliance with Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2022, as amended, the national department of Human Settlements re-allocates funds to Mpumalanga (R100 million) and Northern Cape (R100 million) for the Human Settlements Development Grant, following revised allocations by the national department of Human Settlements.
- c) In compliance with Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2022, as amended, the national department of Human Settlements stops the transfer of funds to Free State (R50 million) Gauteng (R200 million) and Limpopo (R44.7 million) for the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant, following revised allocations by the national department of Human Settlements.
- d) In compliance with Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2022, as amended, the national department of Human Settlements re-allocates funds to Mpumalanga (R200 million) and Northern Cape (R94.7 million) for the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant, following revised allocations by the national department of Human Settlements.
