APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL OF AN INDIVIDUAL SUBSCRIPTION BROADCASTING SERVICE LICENCE AND A RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM LICENCE BY ELECTRONIC MEDIA NETWORK (PTY) LTD

- The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it has received an application from Electronic Media Network (Pty) Ltd ("the Applicant") to renew its Individual Subscription Broadcasting Service Licence and accompanying Radio Frequency Spectrum Licence.
- The application is submitted in terms of Regulation 10 of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Individual Licences, 2010 as amended; read with section 11 of the Electronic Communications Act, No. 36 of 2005, as amended ("EC Act").

- 4. In terms of section 11(3) read with section 9(2) of the EC Act, the Authority is required to give notice of the application in the Government Gazette and invite interested persons to submit written representations in relation to the application.
- 5. The Applicant submits that it is a level 1 BBBEEE contributor as required by the Regulations in respect of the Limitations of Control and Equity Ownership by

Historically Disadvantaged Groups (HDGs) and the application of the ICT Sector Code, 2021.
