THE DEPOSIT INSURANCE REGULATIONS OF 2024

REQUIREMENTS FOR MONTHLY DATA SUBMISSIONS TO THE CORPORATION FOR DEPOSIT INSURANCE

Regulation 28(1) of the Deposit Insurance Regulations of 2024 (Regulations) requires a bank to submit its total qualifying deposits and total covered deposits to the Corporation for Deposit Insurance (CODI) on a monthly basis, using month-end balances, in the manner and form prescribed by CODI.

Regulation 39(1) of the Regulations specifies that CODI may, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, specify the form as well as the content of reporting and submitting information in terms of the Regulations.

In accordance with the provisions of regulation 39(1) read with regulation 28(1) of the Regulations, CODI hereby gives notice of the requirements for monthly data submissions.

The requirements for monthly data submissions as set out in the attached Schedule are applicable from 1 April 2024.

SCHEDULE

REQUIREMENTS FOR MONTHLY DATA SUBMISSIONS TO THE CORPORATION FOR DEPOSIT INSURANCE

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1. Data requirements

1.1 Banks must submit the data fields specified in Table 1 for monthly data submissions.

2. Data submission format

Banks must submit the required data fields to CODI in a comma-separated value (CSV) data format.

3. Data submission period

To facilitate a smooth transition into reporting, a distinction is made between the first data submission period and the business-as-usual data submission period.

3.1 First data submission period

- 3.1.1 Banks must submit their total qualifying deposits², total covered deposits³ and the applicable declarations⁴ to CODI within 10 working days starting from 1 April 2024.
- 3.1.2 The first data submission must be based on the March 2024 month-end balances.

3.2 Business-as-usual data submission period

- 3.2.1 The business-as-usual data submission period is the standard requirement that banks must adhere to in all the months following the first data submission period, i.e. for all the monthly balance submissions starting with the end of April 2024 submissions.
- 3.2.2 Banks must submit their total qualifying deposits, total covered deposits to CODI within 10 working days following the month-end to which the data submission relates.

4. Data submission channels

CODI will provide banks with access to its information technology (IT) system. Banks must use this IT system to upload their monthly data submissions and applicable declarations.

5. Declarations required by the Corporation for Deposit Insurance

Chapter V of the Deposit Insurance Regulations of 2024 (Regulations) requires banks to submit declarations to CODI on a monthly basis in order to fulfil the compliance and oversight requirements of the Regulations.

5.1 Submission of declarations

- 5.1.1 Banks must upload their declarations on CODI's IT system in the Portable Document Format (PDF).
- 5.1.2 If a bank is not able to submit the declaration(s) on CODI's IT system, then the declaration(s) must be emailed to CODISupport@resbank.co.za within three (3) working days of submitting the data to CODI.
- 5.1.3 Where applicable, banks must submit Declaration A1⁵ within 10 working days immediately following the month-end to which the data submission relates.

6. Data resubmissions and declarations

Data resubmissions occur when a bank resubmits information that has already been submitted to CODI. All data resubmissions must be accompanied by the applicable declarations as required by Chapter V of the Regulations.
