## NATURE OF CONTRAVENTION

Guilty of contravention of Ru I e 3.1(a) of the Rules of Conduct for Registered Persons promulgated under Board Notice 41 of 2017, Government Gazette number 40691 of 7 March 2017.

## SANCTION

- 1. The Respondent in terms of the provisions of section 32(3)(a)(i), is cautioned and reprimanded not to conduct himself in the manner he did in the future.
- 2. The Respondent is liable for the amount of R 10 000 (Ten Thousand Rand) in terms of section 32(3)(a)(ii) of the Act. R 5 000 (Five Thousand Rand) of which is payable within a period of 60 (sixty) days from date hereof and R 5 000 (Five Thousand Rand) which is wholly suspended for a period of 5 (five) years in terms of the provisions of section 32(3)(a)(ii) of the Act.
