SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Notice —

“the Industry Waste Tyre Management Plan” means the Industry Waste Tyre Management Plan, as published in Government Notice R.4542 in *Government Gazette* No. 50322 of 20 March 2024.

Substitution of paragraph 4.2 of the Industry Waste Tyre Management Plan

2. Paragraph 4.2 of the Industry Waste Tyre Management Plan is hereby substituted for the following paragraph:

“4.2 The need for an Industry Advisory Committee

An IAC must be established by the Minister within 120 days after the approval of the IndWTMP to support the implementation of the IndWTMP. The role of the IAC is to advise each Implementer to ensure the effective management of waste tyres in line with the objectives of the IndWTMP and the achievement of the targets.”
