I, Barbara Dallas Creecy, Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, hereby consult on my intention to release the land indicated below from being part of the Farm 1363 Rabula Woodlot State forest, so that it can be utilised by the National Department responsible for public works and infrastructure, for non-forestry purposes, in terms of section 50(3) and (4) of the National Forests Act, 1998 (Act No. 84 of 1998).

The parcel of land to be released is an 11-hectare portion of Farm 1363 Rabula Woodlot, located in the Keiskammahoek forest estate, which is situated at Amahlathi Local Municipality, within the Amathole District Municipality of the Eastern Cape Province, measuring 16 hectares. The Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment does not require the land for forestry purposes.
