DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT**NOTICE 2690 OF 2024****INVITATION FOR NOMINATION AND APPLICATION TO SERVE AS A MEMBER OF THE AIR SERVICES LICENSING COUNCIL (ALSC) AND THE INTERNATIONAL AIR SERVICES COUNCIL (IASC)**

The Minister of Transport hereby calls for the appointment and nomination of the persons to serve as Members of the Air Services Licensing Council (ASLC) and the International Air Services Council (IASC). The Air Services Licensing Council and the International Air Services Licensing Councils are statutory bodies established in terms of Section 3(1) of the Air Services Licensing Act, 1990 (Act no 115 of 1990) and Section 3(1) of the International Air Services Act, 1993 (Act No. 60 of 1993) respectively. These Councils are concerned with the licensing and control of domestic and international air services. In addition, they are responsible for the promotion of high standards of safety and to ensure that the domestic and international air services are rendered within the legislative framework.

The Minister of Transport intends to appoint ten (10) members to serve in the ASLC and IASC. The applicants or nominated persons shall be persons who in the opinion of the Minister, on account of their training or experience serving in committees and have qualifications and knowledge in Civil Aviation (Technical Aviation, Airline Industry, Aviation Safety, Security & Environment), Law (Legal and Aviation Compliance, Aviation Law, Company Law, Litigations), Finance (Auditing), Engineering (Aeronautical), Transport Management/ Economics or Tourism.

Council Members of the ASLC and IASC are part-time and will be appointed for a period of three (03) years, effective from 01 April 2025 until 31 March 2028.

Interviews and security screening will be conducted for nominees who are shortlisted. Council Members are required to meet at least once a month during normal working hours between 8:00 and 16:00 but not more than two (02) times a month. The Council's remuneration and allowances will be in accordance with the National Treasury Regulations as prescribed in terms of both Section 7(1) of the International Air Service Act (Act. 60 of 1993) and the Air Service Licensing Act 115 of 1990 respectively. For compensation of preparation of meetings, only two (2) days will be allowed for each meeting.

A nomination must contain the full name and contact details of the person making the nomination, a signed acceptance of the nomination by the nominee, an ID copy, and the Curriculum Vitae of the nominee providing, amongst others, the nominee's: Full name and gender, contact address, telephone and e-mail address, previous experience and relevant expertise, quoting dates and organizations concerned, Academic qualifications and other Board membership(s).
