### **SCHEDULE**

### **Guidance document for Continuing Professional Development**

- 1. In these rules, "the Act" shall mean the Pharmacy Act, 53 of 1974, as amended, and any expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear such meaning.
- 2. The following rule to the *Guidance document for Continuing Professional Development* is hereby **amended**:
  - a) Rule 9(g) Requirements relating to CPD for persons registered with Council



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## REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO CPD FOR PERSONS REGISTERED WITH COUNCIL

Rule 9(g), which currently reads:

"A grace period ending on 30 April of the subsequent year of submission will be allowed;"

shall hereby be replaced with:

"A grace period ending on the last day of February (i.e., 28 or 29 February)\_of the subsequent year of submission will be allowed;"
