

BOARD NOTICE 663 OF 2024**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE DEFINING OF A PRODUCTION AREA
NUVELD-KAROO (DISTRICT)**

(In terms of Section 6 of the Wine of Origin Scheme published by Government Notice No. R.1434 of 29 June 1990)

Please take note that J W Potgieter applied to the Wine Certification Authority to define Nuvelde-Karoo (District) as a production area to produce Wine of Origin.

The main characteristic of the Nuvelde-Karoo District is that an attempt has been made to maintain 1300 m above sea level. The height above sea level of Nuvelde-Karoo is 1313 m – 1962 m (an average of 1523 m). It will be the highest district (on average) after Central Drakensberg (1436 m average) and Sutherland-Karoo (1422 m average).

The northern border runs on the Western Cape's border (just south of Loxton) and the southern border runs on the 1500 m contour line of the Nuweveldberge, just north of Beaufort West. The gap on the east runs on the eastern boundaries of farms 2/49; RE/49; 396; 395; RE/75, where the Krom River flows past Bobbejaanskop.
