DRAFT MERCHANT SHIPPING/MARINE POLLUTION (IBC CODE) REGULATIONS, 2024

The Minister of Transport intends, in terms of section 356(2)(a) of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1951 (Act No. 57 of 1951) and section 3 of the Marine Pollution (Prevention of Pollution from Ships) Act, 1986 (Act No. 2 of 1986) to repeal the Merchant Shipping/Marine Pollution (IBC Code) Regulations, 1998 published by GNR. 133 in Government Gazette 18631 (RG 6082) of 23 January 1998 and promulgate the Draft Merchant Shipping/Marine Pollution (IBC Code) Regulations, 2024, as set out in the Schedule published in the South African Maritime Safety Authority website at Draft Regulations (samsa.org.za).
