Conditions 8. (GENERAL CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL) of the Interim Decision must be complied with.

In accordance with the Rationalization of Local Government Affairs, Act 10 of 1998, the applicant must advertise this final approval in the Provincial Government Gazette within 30 days of receipt of this letter. The template is included in **Annexure A**.

A copy of the advert shall be submitted to the City within 7 days of publication. The City will consider your application as incomplete should you fail to advertise and submit the proof of advert within the prescribed time and you will have to restart the renewal process again.

The abovementioned restrictions will officially come into operation two months from the date of display in the Provincial Government Gazette <u>and shall be valid for two years.</u>

The applicant can lodge an appeal to the Office of the City Manager within 21 days of notification of the City's final decision, as provided for in terms of the Municipal Systems Act, 32 of 2000 if the applicant is not satisfied with the final decision. The notice of appeal must be in writing and must set out fully the reasons why an appeal is being lodged.

The appeal must be lodged at the following address:

An appeal must comply strictly with the time limits stipulated in Section 62 of the Municipal Systems Act. The notice of appeal must be in writing and must set out fully the reasons why an appeal is being lodged. (See Section 8, Annexure C, of the procedure document of the security access restriction policy).
