- In terms of section 13(6) read with section 9(2), of the ECA, the Authority is required to publish a notice in the Government Gazette inviting interested parties to submit written representations on the transfer application.
- 4. The transfer application seeks approval from the Authority to transfer ownership of the I-ECS licence from the Applicant to the Transferee, and will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:
 - a. promotion of competition in the ICT sector;
 - b. interests of consumers; and
 - c. equity ownership by Historically Disadvantaged Persons ("HDPs").
