ORDER

After having read the papers filed on behalf of the Applicant, it is ordered as follows:

1. The Applicant's deviation from the rules in launching this Application is condoned and the forms and time periods for service provided for in the Rules are dispensed with and the Application is dealt with as one of urgency in terms of Rule 12(2) of the Special Tribunal Rules;
2. Pending the finalisation of the action instituted in the High Court by the Applicant against *inter alia* the First Respondent under Case number 7760/18, the First Respondent is interdicted and restrained from withdrawing and/or in any other way encumbering or prejudicing the value of monies held or administered by the Second and Third Respondents, as pension fund benefits, due to the First Respondent;
3. Pending the finalisation of the action instituted in the High Court by the Applicant under Case number 7760/18, the Second and Third Respondents are interdicted and restrained

from paying out to the First Respondent and/or any other party, and from doing anything that may in any other way encumber or prejudice the value of the monies held or administered by it/them, as pension fund benefits, due to the First Respondent;

4. The Second and Third Respondents must within 60 (sixty) days of this order assess the value of the First Respondent's pension benefit and notify the parties in writing thereof;
5. The First Respondent may apply on the present papers, duly supplemented, for any relief the First Respondent considers appropriate, if the pension benefit due to the First Respondent (as assessed by the Second and Third Respondents) is in excess of the Applicant's claim instituted in the High Court under Case number 7760/18, including an estimated amount of costs and interest;
6. Costs of this application are costs in the action under Case number 7760/18.
