## AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 4: MANNER OF CALCULATING COMPENSATION

Under Section 55 of the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act, 1993 (Act No. 130 of 1993), I, Nomakhosazana Meth, Minister of Employment and Labour, hereby issue a notice of intention to amend Schedule 4 for accidents that occur from 1st April 2025 as well as occupational diseases diagnosed from the 1st April 2025. The minimum and maximum compensation set out in this notice will be implemented with effect from 1st April 2025.

#### INCREASE IN MONTHLY PENSIONS

I, Nomakhosazana Meth, Minister of Employment and Labour, in terms of Section 57 (1) of the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act, 1993 (Act No. 130 of 1993 as amended), hereby increase monthly pensions, payable in terms of Section 49 (4) and 54 (1) (a), (b), (c) and (d) by 5% and Constant Attendance Allowances by 6% with regards to accidents which occurred before 31st March 2025 as well as occupational diseases which were diagnosed before 31st March 2025.

The increases are with effect from 01st April 2025.
