## CONSULTATION ON APPLICATIONS RECEIVED FOR THE EXCLUSION OF A WASTE STREAM OR A PORTION OF A WASTE STREAM FOR BENEFICIAL USE FROM THE DEFINITION OF WASTE

I, Dion Travers George, Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, hereby in terms of regulation 6(3) of the Regulations regarding the exclusion of a waste stream or a portion of a waste stream from the definition of waste, 2018 (the Regulations), read with sections 72 and 73 of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008), consult on my intention to take decisions on applications received for the exclusion of a waste stream or a portion of a waste stream from the definition of waste for a certain beneficial use, as indicated in the Schedule hereto.

The Regulations prescribe the manner in which a person or a category of persons may apply for the exclusion of a waste stream or a portion of a waste stream from the definition of waste. The Regulations sets out the process and procedure to be followed before decisions on the applications are taken.

In consideration of the applications, the criteria contemplated in regulation 7 and the risk assessment contemplated in regulation 8 of the Regulations, must be taken into account. Once a waste stream has been excluded from the definition of waste, a risk management plan, which is based on the risk assessment, must be complied with. Annual reports in terms of regulation 10 of the Regulations must be sent to the Department.
