NOTICE OF THE NATIONAL NUCLEAR REGULATOR (NNR) PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON HEALTH, SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES PERTAINING TO THE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION SUBMITTED BY ESKOM FOR KOEBERG UNIT 2.

Further to the public hearings held in 2024, Eskom has submitted additional information to the NNR in connection with the application to extend the operating life of the Koeberg Nuclear Power Station (KNPS) by 20 years. In this regard, the NNR hereby invites members of the public and interested and affected parties to submit written comments on health, safety and environmental issues pertaining to the additional information submitted by Eskom for Koeberg Unit 2.
