## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF PERSONS TO SERVE AS MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN COUNCIL FOR PLANNERS

## PLANNING PROFESSION ACT 2002, (ACT NO. 36 OF 2002)

Under section 4(3) of the Planning Profession Act 2002 (Act No. 36 of 2002) (PPA), I, Nomtandazo Moyo, Acting Director-General of the Department of Land Reform and Rural Development on behalf of the Minister, hereby invite interested persons, voluntary associations, institutions and organisations to submit nominations of suitably qualified persons to serve as member(s) of the South African Council for Planners (SACPLAN) in terms of the Planning Profession Act.

The Council is appointed for a period of four (4) years and nominations are requested for the following categories to Constitute the Council:

- **Two (2)** planners in the full-time employ of the Department of Land Reform and Rural Development, in terms of Section 4(1)(a).
- **One (1)** planner in the employ of provincial government, nominated by the provincial government, in terms of Section 4(1)(b).
- **Two (2)** planners in the employ of the municipal sphere of government (one from a municipality which is mainly rural in character and the other from a municipality mainly urban in character), nominated by the municipality or an association representing planners at the municipal level or representing the interests of local government sphere of government, in terms of Section 4(1)(c).
- **Three (3)** planners from the planning education and training sector, nominated by the Committee of University Principals, or education and training institutions that offers training on the subject matter, in terms of Section 4(1)(d).
- **Three (3)** persons to represent the interest of communities whom or may be affected by planning decisions nominated by interested persons, voluntary associations and organisations, in terms of Section 4(1)(e).
- **Three (3)** planners in private practice nominated by association(s) or institutions representing planners in private practice or representing the interest of planners in general, in terms of Section 4(1)(f).

The Minister, together with the Acting Director-General as applicable, shall consider nominations and give due regard to the planning profession principles contained in Section 2 of the PPA, the diversity of interests and the need to ensure and promote gender, disability, and other demographic representation when appointing members of the SACPLAN.

  - The candidate's full names, ID number and gender. Contact address, telephone, as well as an e-mail address (if any) and professional registration number.
  - Experience, knowledge and skills with specific regard to expertise in the planning to profession.
  - Certified copies of academic qualifications and supporting information.
  - At least three (3) names and contact details of referees.
3. A signed letter of acceptance of the nomination by the nominee.

The Selection Panel will make recommendations to the Minister of Land Reform and Rural Development on the appointment of members to the Council of SACPLAN. Should nominees not hear from the Department two months after the closing date of the call for nominations, it should be taken that the candidate was not successful.
