TOLL REBATE FOR FREQUENT USERS**

The Head of Department hereby, in terms of section 28(4) read with section 27(1)(e) of the South African National Roads Agency Limited and National Roads Act, 1998 (Act No. 7 of 1998) ("the Act"), gives notice of the temporary suspension of the obligation to pay toll in the form of a 100% Frequent User rebate on toll fees, to registered SANRAL Frequent User account holders.

This temporary 100% Frequent User rebate shall apply from 00h00 on 1 October 2025 until 23h59 on 2 December 2025, or such earlier date as may be determined should the bridge repairs at the R102 uMzimkhulu river, be completed at an earlier date.

The 100% Frequent User rebate shall apply exclusively to registered SANRAL Frequent User account holders whose accounts are in good standing and whose vehicles are duly registered and fitted with valid SANRAL electronic tags (TollTags).

The 100% Frequent User rebate shall only be applicable to travel undertaken in either direction on the N2 South Coast Toll Road between the Oribi Northern Local Toll Ramp Plaza and the Umtentweni Southern on- and off-ramps (Rethman Drive Interchange).

Upon expiry of this temporary suspension period, the above 100% Frequent User rebate shall be withdrawn. Registered SANRAL Frequent Users who meet the criteria for the standard Frequent User Discounts will continue to receive such discounts as outlined in paragraph 6 of Government Gazette No. 52073, Volume 716, published on 7 February 2025.

TOLAFSLAG VIR GEREELDE TOL GEBRUIKERS**

Die Departementshoof gee hiermee, ingevolge artikel 28(4) gelees saam met artikel 27(1)(e) van die Wet op Die Suid-Afrikaanse Nasionale Padagentskap Beperk en Nasionale Paaie, 1998 (Wet No. 7 van 1998) ("die Wet"), kennis van die tydelike opskorting van die verpligting om tol te betaal in die vorm van 'n 100% Gereelde Gebruiker afslag op tolfooie aan geregistreerde SANRAL Gereelde Gebruiker rekeninghouers.

Hierdie tydelike 100% Gereelde Gebruiker tolaflaag sal van toepassing wees vanaf 00h00 op 1 Oktober 2025 tot 23h59 op 2 Desember 2025, of so 'n vroeër datum as wat bepaal mag word indien die brug herstelwerk by die R102 uMzimkhulurivier op 'n vroeër datum, voltooi word.

Die 100% Gereelde Gebruiker tolaflaag sal uitsluitlik van toepassing wees op geregistreerde SANRAL Gereelde Gebruiker rekeninghouers wie se rekening in goeie stand is en wie se voertuie behoorlik geregistreer is en toegerus is met 'n geldige SANRAL-elektroniese skyfie (TolSkyfie).

Die 100% Gereelde Gebruiker tolaflaag is slegs van toepassing op reise wat in enige rigting onderneem word op die N2 Suidkus Tolpad tussen die Oribi Noordelike Plaaslike Tol op- en afrit Plazas en die Umtentweni Suidelike op- en afritte (Rethmanrylaan-Wisselaar).

By die verstryking van hierdie tydelike opskortingstydperk, sal bogenoemde 100% Gereelde Gebruiker-afslag teruggetrek word. Geregistreerde SANRAL Gereelde Gebruikers wat aan die vereistes vir die standaard Gereelde Gebruiker-afslag voldoen, sal steeds sodanige afslag ontvang soos uiteengesit in paragraaf 6 van Staatskoerant Nr. 52073, Volume 716, gepubliseer op 7 Februarie 2025.
