- Above rates will be valid from the 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2026 until further notice.
- In all instances where a service is delivered and unit rates are not sufficient to cover costs, the PPECB will retain the right to, at its discretion, charge hour and or kilometre rates as listed above instead of or in addition to the published fees. For administrative purposes hour and kilometre rates may be adapted to an equivalent tariff per unit.
- Where hourly rates are charged, a minimum fee for a one-hour call-out will be charged. Thereafter, time
  will be charged in half-hour segments, i.e., R 486.12 per half hour or part thereof. The same principle will
  be applied to overtime and Sunday time.
- After-hour callouts are defined as all callouts made outside Normal Time (8 am to 5 pm weekdays) and will be charged at the Normal Overtime or Sunday & Public holiday hour rate.
