**DETERMINATION OF REMUNERATION OF CONSTITUTIONAL COURT JUDGES AND JUDGES**

1. In terms of section 2(1)(a) of the Judges' Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act, 2001 (Act No. 47 of 2001), I hereby determine that, the salaries and allowances of the Constitutional Court judges and judges of other courts shall be as set in the attached Schedule with effect from 1 April 2025, subject to the terms and conditions set out herein.
2. The total remuneration packages shall include the following elements:
 - 2.1 A cash annual salary component of 72.24%; and
 - 2.2 A non-cash component of 27.76% (which includes motor allowance and employer medical contribution).
3. The total remuneration package does not include pension benefits which are separately regulated by the Act.
4. Notice No. 201 published in the *Government Gazette* No. 51413 of 18 October 2024 is hereby repealed.
