NOTICE OF NERSA'S PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ELECTRICITY TARIFF APPLICATIONS FOR EKURHULENI METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY, MSUNDUZI LOCAL MUNICIPALITY AND MADIBENG MUNICIPALITY FOR PURPOSES OF REDETERMINING THE 2024/25 FINANCIAL YEAR TARIFFS OF THE RESPECTIVE MUNICIPALITIES

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), the Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

On 14 January 2026, the High Court of South Africa, Gauteng Division, Pretoria reviewed and set aside the NERSA approved 2024/2025 Municipal tariffs for Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality, Msunduzi Local Municipality and Madibeng Municipality, ordering the said Municipalities to resubmit compliant tariff applications and cost of supply studies within ten days of the order and directing NERSA to redetermine the tariffs by no later than 30 June 2026.

NERSA hereby invites members of the public to submit comments on the tariff applications and the cost of supply studies.
