

BOARD NOTICE 941 OF 2026

BEFORE THE DISCIPLINARY TRIBUNAL OF THE ENGINEERING COUNCIL OF SOUTH AFRICA HELD AT JOHANNESBURG ON 15 MAY 2026 VIA MS TEAMS

Publication in terms of section 32(5) of the Engineering Profession Act, 46 of 2000 ("The Act") of the finding and sanction imposed by a Disciplinary Tribunal at a disciplinary hearing, into the alleged improper conduct of a registered person.

NATURE OF CONTRAVENTION

The Respondent pleaded guilty to charge 1 and was found guilty for contravention of Rule 3.1(a), 3.1(b), 3.2(a) and 3.2(b) of the Code of Conduct for Registered Persons promulgated under Board Notice 41 of 2017, Government Gazette number 40961 of 17 March 2021.

SANCTION

The Parties entered into and agreed to a settlement agreement, terms and conditions as follows:

1. In terms of the provisions of section 32(3)(a)(iii) of the EPA, to the suspension of his registration as a registered person with the Council, for a period of 6 **(six)** months, from the date of approval of this agreement by the Disciplinary Tribunal.

2. In terms of the provisions of section 32(3)(a)(ii) of the EPA, a fine in the amount of R40 000 (forty thousand rands), of which R20 000 (twenty thousand rands) of the fine shall be suspended for a period of 24-months from the date of approval of this agreement by the Disciplinary Tribunal, subject to compliance with the terms of this agreement.
3. The R20 000 shall be payable to the Council 30 days upon the approval of this agreement by the Disciplinary Tribunal.
4. The suspended portion of the fine (R20 000) shall only become payable to the Council if, within 24 months of the approval of this agreement by the Disciplinary Tribunal:
 - 4.1 The Respondent is found guilty of further improper conduct in terms of the Council's Code of Conduct; Rules of Conduct; provisions of the EPA or any other rule, regulation, notice, directive, guideline, policy, instruction, determination, or requirement issued by the Council under the auspices of the EPA; and/or
 - 4.2 The Respondent fails to comply with any of the remaining terms and conditions of this agreement.
