**THE DIMENSION OF, DESIGN FOR, AND COMPILATION OF THE YEAR 2026  
COMMEMORATIVE CIRCULATION COINS UNDER THE THEME OF  
'EDUCATION'**

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 19(1) (a) of the South African Reserve Bank Act 90 of 1989, I hereby declare-

- a. that the commemorative circulation coins as set out in section (b) of the Second Schedule of the said Act, which will be manufactured and issued by virtue of section 16 (1) of the said Act, will be legal tender as from 16 June 2026;
- b. that the design of the said coins will be the designs as shown and which are attached to this notice; and
- c. that the specifications of the said coin are as follows:

<b>Denomination<sup>1</sup></b>	<b>Metal content</b>	<b>Diameter<sup>2</sup></b>	<b>Mass<sup>3</sup></b>
R5 (5 Rand)	Bi-metal alloy	26.00 mm	9.5 g
R2 (2 Rand)	Nickel-plated steel	23.00 mm	6.5 g





<sup>1</sup> The denominations are featured on the coins in an abbreviated format (e.g. R2<sup>1</sup>), written out in full (e.g. Two Rand<sup>1</sup>) or a combination of a number and rand (e.g. 2 Rand<sup>1</sup>).

<sup>2</sup> The diameter is the average diameter of the coin as issued.

<sup>3</sup> The standard mass is the average mass of the coin as issued.
