**APPLICATION FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE INDIVIDUAL COMMERCIAL
SOUND BROADCASTING SERVICE AND RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM
LICENCES BY RADIO iGAGASI 99.5 (PTY) LTD T/A iGAGASI 99.5**

1. On 10 December 2025, Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") published a notice¹ in the *government gazette* inviting interested parties to submit written representations and responses in relation to the application within fourteen (14) working days from the date of publication of the notice.
2. The Applicant intends to amend its RFS licence by adding a new transmitter at Empangeni on 102.1 MHz with a maximum Effective Radiated Power ("ERP") of 1 kW.
3. Whilst the Authority was considering the application, the Applicant submitted an amendment of its application on 20 January 2026 by submitting an updated Form P, accompanied by a revised technical feasibility report. The Applicant changed its initially applied frequency 102.1 MHz to 89.6 MHz to improve iGagasi 99.5's coverage area within the boundaries of KwaZulu-Natal Province.
4. The Authority hereby gives notice of the Applicant's amendment application received on 20 January 2026, consistent with Regulation 8 of the Radio Frequency Spectrum Regulations², 2015 as amended. The interested parties are advised to make comments on the revised RFS licence amendment application received on 20 January 2026.
