SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Schedule "the Regulations" means the Regulations relating to Maintenance published under Government Notice No. R. 1361 of 15 November 1999, as amended by Government Notices No's. R. 1099 of 3 November 2006, R. 966 of 6 September 2017 and R. 1473 of 21 December 2017.

Amendment of regulation 12 of the Regulations

2. Regulation 12 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for subregulation (1) in the Regulations of the following subregulation:

- “(1) Upon the variation or setting aside of an order contemplated in section 19 of the Act, the maintenance officer shall, inform—
- (a) the person required to make a payment in terms of the maintenance order;
 - (b) the person in whose favour the maintenance order has been made; and
 - (c) the person on whom a notice referred to in section 16(3)(a) of the Act has been served,

of the variation or the setting aside of the order by a notice which shall substantially correspond with Form J of the Annexure, and in the event of a variation order, attach a copy of that order to the notice.

(2) The maintenance officer shall keep record of the manner in which the notice referred to in subregulation (1) or (2) was submitted.”.

Amendment of Form J to the Annexure to the Regulations

3. The Annexure to the Regulations is hereby amended by the amendment of Form J:
