- (a) Stopping of allocations in respect of conditional allocations to provinces under the Act; and
- (b) The re-allocation of conditional allocations to provinces.

For ease of reference only and where applicable, the attached Schedule reflects the allocations published in the Division of Revenue Act, 2026 as Column A, stopping of allocations and re-allocations in Column B and the total adjusted allocations in Column C.

Explanatory Memorandum to the Provincial Allocations set out in the Schedule

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2026 (Act No. 9 of 2026), and provides information on adjustments to existing allocations to provinces in the 2026/27 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to stop the flow of funds in terms of Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2026, and to re-allocate the stopped funds to provinces, as approved in terms of Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2026.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Act, 2026.

This notice affects the Public Transport Operations Grant (PTOG)

a) In compliance with Section 18 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2026:

- The national Department of Transport stops the transfer of funds to Eastern Cape (R28.554 million).

b) In compliance with Section 19 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2026:

- The national Department of Transport re-allocates the funds to Free State (R1.310 million), Gauteng (R11.451 million), KwaZulu-Natal (R5.492 million), Limpopo (R1.772 million), Mpumalanga (R2.983 million), Northern Cape (R266 000), North West (R549 000) and Western Cape (R4.731 million), following the revision of allocations.
