

The primary purpose of the lockdown was to start to "flatten the curve", preventing a surge of cases in April and May.










## What did the national lockdown achieve?

- Ramp up testing and prevention strategies





## Why is South Africa easing restrictions now?





While cases are increasing, we have **prepared the health** system to provide care to all those who need it.

By following basic precautions, we can keep transmission low and protect our healthcare workers.











At Level 3, it is up to all South Africans to stop the spread of the coronavirus. You can protect yourself, your family and your community by:



Wearing a cloth

mask in whenever in public, making
sure to cover your mouth and nose



Keeping a distance of 11/2 metres from other people



Washing your hands regularly with soap and water or using sanitiser



Cleaning surfaces regularly













Public adherence to **basic precautions** can dramatically **reduce the spread** of the virus.

We can change the course of the epidemic in South Africa if we all follow the rules.











#### This stage of our response includes four interventions:



- Basic precautions to prevent the spread of the coronavirus
- Identification of hotspots to control outbreaks
- Targeted testing and contact tracing
- Medical care for those who are infected












#### Special measures will apply in hotspot areas:

Hotspots will be determined based on the number of active cases per 100,000 in the population, the rate of increase in active cases, and the capacity of the health system.



Dedicated, multidisciplinary teams will be deployed to contain the outbreak



Each hotspot will be linked to testing and quarantine facilities, and additional hospital beds



All contacts will be traced and isolated to prevent further transmission
