TRIBUTE TO THE LATE COMRADE JACKSON MVELASE FORMER MINISTER IN THE PRESIDENCY – 5 June 1958 – 21 January 2021

The June and Andrew Mlangeni Foundation is saddened to learn about Cde Jackson Mthembu's passing and would like to express the organizations heartfelt condolences to the late Comrade Jackson Mthembu's wife, children, family, the community of Emalahleni, friends, colleagues in Government and Comrades.

Minister Jackson Mthembu dedicated himself in the student's struggles against apartheid during his formative years. The commitments he made as a young activists carried him through to be a significant player at the formation of the United Democratic Front (UDF), which was formed around 1983. Quite early in life of THE UDF he emerged as an organizer and an effective communicator. One of the tasks which he performed with excellence was to mobilse the churches around the course for liberation under the banner of South African Council of Churches.

The June and Andrew Mlangeni foundation is grateful that he worked very closely with Mme June Mlangeni who was working at the SACC ,at the time and she did not only mentor activists in the offices of the SACC but opened, her house as a shelter for committed activists like Cde Jackson Mvelase. He publicly supported the establishment of the state capture commission chaired by Deputy Chief Justice, Mr Raymond Zondo.
