LEVEL 3 requires greater responsibility & discipline from all of us as citizens of this resilient nation.

Washing hands, wearing masks, 1.5m social distancing and health & hygiene protocols.



MASKS

Masks are mandatory in public.



CURFEW

9pm-5am.

Exceptions: medical/security emergency or services with permit (Form 7)



ALCOHOL

No sales, dispensing, distribution or transit.
No public consumption.

Exceptions incl export, storage as listed in Regulations



GATHERINGS

All social gatherings are prohibited

(incl faith-based, political, traditional council, sports grounds/fields)



FUNERALS

Max 50 people; with mask, social distance & health protocols. Under 2 hrs.

No night vigils No post-events



RECREATION

Indoor <50, outdoor <100 people; venue too small for protocols: 50%cap. Close 8pm

Incl cinemas, theatres, casinos, museums, galleries, restaurants, gyms, conferences, auctions (capacity certificate displayed)



RECREATION

Botanical gardens, aquariums, zoos, other parks with access control and entry limitations open 09h00-18h00;

Game parks 06h00-18h00



CLOSED PUBLIC SPACES

Hotspots: All beaches, dams, lakes & rivers, all recreational facilities closed.

(Fishermen with permits allowed)

Non-Hotspots: open 06:00-19:00



CLOSED PUBLIC PLACES

Night clubs, taverns, shebeens, public parks, public swimming pools

(Professional athlete training allowed)



SPORT

- Sporting activities incl professional & non-professional matches allowed
- No spectators



INITIATION

Initiation schools, practices, post-initiation celebrations prohibited



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- Long distance (>200km) Buses/taxis 70% cap
- All other 100% cap



BORDERS

- All land ports of entry closed until 15 Feb 2021 (with exceptions as in Regulations)
- Rail, ocean, air, road open for movement of cargo to and from countries
