








SPECIAL TRIBUNAL JUDGEMENT ORDER ON SAP/DWS

The R1 billion software license and support agreement contract concluded between SAP and Department of Water and Sanitation has been declared constitutionally

The Special Tribunal ordered that SAP repay DWS the amount of R413 million of the software license contracts, which



represents the total amount paid by DWS to SAP.
