Anti-Corruption Headlines 01-07 Oct 2022

- SIU collaborated with the Asset Forfeiture Unit to obtain a preservation order to freeze assets worth approximately R22 million, which are the proceeds of unlawful activities at the National Lotteries Commission.
- Former Managing Director of Clerdata was found guilty by the Bellville Specialised Commercial Crimes Court for 30 separate charges of fraud and forgery including 19 counts of theft of R4.8 million and eight counts of forgery amounting to over R500 000.

- SIU and the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) have signed a settlement agreement with EOH, a JSE listed IT company, to pay back over R178 million, plus interest The money was irregularly received from its dealings with DWS between 2012 and 2017.
- The Specialised Commercial Crimes Court has found an official of the Siyathemba Local Municipality in Northern Cape guilty of fraud and forgery after she misrepresented herself in a CV. She claimed to be in possession of a matric certificate.




Anti-Corruption Headlines 15-21 Oct 2022

- The Hawks arrested a Limpopo businessman for defrauding a victim of R1.9 million in a tender scam. It is alleged that he identified himself as one of the senior officials at Atok mine to his victim and requested payment of R1.9 million to get a tender worth R11 million.
- The Durban Serious Corruption Investigation (Hawks) arrested two people for fraud and money laundering.
 It is alleged they made fictitious payments of more than R100 million.

- The former Municipal Manager and the former mayor of Elias Motsoaledi Municipality, who is currently Mayor of the Sekhukhune District Municipality, appeared in court for corruption, money laundering, contravention of the Municipal Finance Management Act and the Banks Act. This is in relation to the VBS Mutual Bank investments of R190 million municipal funds and R300 000-00 in gratification.
- The outgoing chairman of the SADC Anti-Corruption Committee (SACC), Adv Andy Mothibi hosted the SADC heads of Anti-Corruption Agencies. The committee implements the SADC Strategic Anti-Corruption Action Plan (2023-2027) and enhances collaboration between SADC Secretariat and Member States. The incoming chairperson is Mr Paulus Noa, the Director-General of the Anti-Corruption Commission of Namibia.
