Through a set of focused and ambitious actions, the plan will place South Africa on a new growth trajectory. These include:

- A new paradigm for energy, including new generation capacity to achieve sufficient, secure and reliable energy supply within two years;
- An employment stimulus to create jobs and support livelihoods, with over 800 000 work opportunities through public and social employment;
- Renewed support for South African businesses, pursuing new areas of growth through industrialisation, localisation and export promotion; and
- Fast-tracking reforms for a more competitive and inclusive economy, focusing on efficient and world-class energy, water, telecommunications, ports, rail and roads.

The plan is about implementation and accountability, and prioritises actions with the highest impact to restore economic growth.
